Javier Vallhonrat (Madrid, 1953) lives and works in Madrid. Bachelor of Fine Arts and Psychology, Gestalt Therapist and Integrative Humanist Therapist, this artist chooses photography as his privileged means of research, exploring its limits as a language, and making it dialogue with painting, video, performance, word or installation.

Over more than three decades, he has simultaneously developed his work with a teaching activity in public and private institutions in Austria, Belgium, Canada, Spain, France, Finland, Italy, Japan, Mexico and the United Kingdom.

During the last years he has worked in particular geoclimatic environments, carrying out long-term projects that he continues to develop today.

This artist's work has been exhibited in numerous museums and institutions around the world, and is found in collections such as the Reina Sofía Museum in Madrid, the Grand Duc Jean of Luxembourg or the Museum of Modern Art in Philadelphia, among others.

17 monographs of his work have been published, his work having been recognized with numerous awards, including the National Photography Prize, the Photography Prize of the Community of Madrid, the Photography Prize of the Madrid City Council and the Prize Bartolomé Ros from PhotoEspaña.
